DAY 1: Depart IAD

DAY 2: AMSTERDAM-Arrive at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, where you will be transferred to the ship.

DAY 3: COLOGNE - Cologne walking tour with choice of cathedral OR Kölsch beer tasting OR Museum Ludwig
 You have an array of choices for how you wish to experience Cologne's many treasures. Those interested in history and architecture will want to stroll with a local expert through Old Town to the city's iconic UNESCO Gothic Cologne Cathedral. For beer connoisseurs, you'll wish to visit a brewery to taste the traditional local brew of the city, Kölsch. And for lovers of art, you won't want to miss one of the most important contemporary museums in Europe, Museum Ludwig. Cap the day off at the Captain's Welcome Reception and Gala Dinner. Note: On Sundays and Catholic holidays, guided tours inside the cathedral are not allowed, but individual visits are still welcomed.

DAY 4: CRUISING THE ROMANTIC RHINE RIVER, RÜDESHEIM Choice of gondola ride to the Niederwald Monument OR Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum Experience Rudesheim from above on a cable car ride over Rheingau vineyards or visit a unique collection of self-playing musical instruments. Later, cruise through the UNESCO-designated Upper Middle Rhine.

DAY 5: FRANKFURT Choice of Frankfurt city tour OR exclusive "Do as the Locals Do" Frankfurt walking tour. Get an overview of modern-day Frankfurt as well as its charming Old Town, or experience Frankfurt as a local.

DAY 6: WERTHEIM : Wertheim walking tour with pretzel making and wine tasting at a private wine estate Stroll through Wertheim's historic center and enjoy a private wine tasting and pretzel making with a baker.

DAY 7: WÜRZBURG: Würzburg Residence visit Art lovers will enjoy a visit to the Würzburg Residence.

Note: If the tour lands on a day when the BMW factory is closed, we'll visit the Audi factory. The Audi production line is closed on weekends, so if your visit is scheduled for a weekend, you'll see the Audi museum.
