

QUEEN OF THE NILE *Aug 13, 2021*

Learning Journeys' women-only program is created by women, for women and in support of women. Through private workshops, historical immersion, and hands-on local cooking and lifestyle experiences, the tour company's new Queen of the Nile program offers immersive learning while celebrating and supporting local women's initiatives.

The nine-day Queen of the Nile program is designed for no more than eight women and will feature a perfume workshop to discover the history of Egyptian perfumery; insights into the Egypt Mag Women's Empowerment Project to learn about this advocacy movement's work; local cooking experience to prepare and enjoy authentic Egyptian cuisine; historical immersion with an Egyptologist to explore the legacy of the pyramids, the Sphinx, the treasures of King Tutankhamen; a henna workshop in a local Nubian village, and a brunch in a local Egyptian woman's home. When booked before Sept. 30 for any departure in 2021 and 2022, there are no single supplements for a savings of \$1,500.

On all other Learning Journeys, travelers who register by Aug. 31, 2021 can receive an early booking incentive of \$200 per traveler, per booking and Learning Journeys will give back by making a contribution of \$100 per traveler, per booking, to Purkal Youth Development Society in Purkal, India.

Learning Journeys is a traveling classroom for all ages offering a breadth of global, in-depth learning itineraries. Each program is designed for participants to find purpose while cultivating a relationship between themselves and the destinations they're exploring so that every journey is a mutually beneficial experience. Programs vary in theme and locale and each features hands-on learning with skilled experts, artisans, and teachers, and is designed to contribute to the communities visited in sustainable and meaningful ways. Private journeys, semi-private, and small group experiences provide enticing and engaging ways for participants to learn about new cultures, enjoy new experiences, and spend valuable quality time together.

Dr. Carol Dimopoulos, CEO of Learning Journeys, founded it as part of Perillo Tours in 2014, but negotiated its independent acquisition in 2020 while receiving her doctorate of education in global education and leadership from the University of Illinois, Urbana Champaign. Taking the creed to "leave the world a little bit better than you found it" to heart, Dimopoulos works to infuse every Learning Journeys program with locally based experiences that contribute to the communities visited. These sustainable community interactions are central to the continuing education programs she has personally researched and developed around the world.

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
