

# Lindblad Expeditions Set to Explore the Pacific Northwest on the Salish Sea ~ Families ~ Solo ~ Groups ~ Adventure Travel

Based on current Canadian travel restrictions for COVID, Lindblad Expeditions has announced a revised itinerary for its October 2021 British Columbia and San Juan Islands voyage that will now provide guests with an American wildness experience in the Salish Sea.

“Exploring the Pacific Northwest: The Jewels of The Salish Sea” will discover the remoteness and majesty of the Pacific Northwest on a wide-ranging exploration of Puget Sound and the San Juan Islands in northern Washington State aboard the 100-guest National Geographic Venture. Guests will explore isolated bays and islets by kayak, hike meadows and green forest trails, and gain an unmatched vantage point on this stunning region.

The seven-night expedition will sail round-trip from Seattle, offering a wildness close to home. Additional highlights include: hikes and breathtaking views in Olympic National Park, a World Heritage Site, an exploration of Hurricane Ridge, Marymere Falls and more; a look at the fascinating world of photogenic fungi on a one-of-a-kind expert-led foraging experience; and a visit to exclave of Point Roberts, Wash., an area that has been cut off from the rest of the world as a result of politics and the pandemic.

Guests will also get the chance to enjoy local wine and beer onboard throughout the trip, and a special farm-to-table dinner. They will get a new perspective on the sea life thriving in these cool, rocky waters through the camera lens of our undersea specialist.

Guests can choose from three departures—Oct. 2, 9 and 16, 2021. Rates begin at \$5,290 per person double in a Category 1 cabin. Lindblad also is offering a \$500 air credit per person on all departures and is waiving the solo premium on the Oct. 16 voyage.
